TUGALO RECORDS' SINGING SENSATION DAVID WILLS TO RELEASE NEW ALBUM OF HIS SONGS

ROYSTON, GA. May 15, 2023 – Tugalo Records and Georgia Legends Concert of Royston are proud to announce another exciting David Wills album release concert set for Friday June 30th, 2023 at 7:00 pm at The Historic Ritz Theatre in Toccoa, Georgia. The excitement continues to build in anticipation of a great show as David Wills is set for a show here in Georgia that also features a local favorite entertainer, the Joe Olds Band of Commerce.

"David Wills is one of Nashville's most treasured vocalists," said Wesley Fricks, President of Tugalo Records and a Royston native. "His baritone sound lends strength and charisma to these mainstream tracks that anyone within an ear's shot of will find transforming and pleasing to the heart!"

The concert will be a set list performance of all of his latest songs on these two albums that he wrote while with Charlie Pride Music Group over the last four decades. He recently performed "There's A Song On The Jukebox" and "From Barrooms To Bedrooms" on the Penny Gilley Show taped in the Stockyards in Fort Worth, Texas and aired on RFD-TV on April 21st of this year.

"I have put my life works in these two albums," says Wills, who broke into the business under Charlie Rich in 1974 who had just released, "Behind Closed Doors" just a year earlier and was the hottest thing in country music at the time. Rich, through his contract, was permitted to sign young and aspiring singers and that is how David Wills got his contract with Epic Records and throttled himself to the top of the business.

David Wills charted twenty-one songs on country Billboard and recorded three country albums between 1974 and 1988. Two of those singles, There's A Song On The Jukebox and From Barrooms To Bedrooms, made it to the top ten. David Wills released a fourth titled, "Line On Love" in 1994. Now he has gone back into the studio for an exciting two album project with Tugalo Records.

As a songwriter, he penned hit songs for stars like George Strait, John Schneider, Keith Whitley, John Michael Montgomery, Patty Loveless, Janie Fricke, Sawyer Brown, and Garth Brooks. He and Bill Shore co-wrote "Wild Horses" for Brooks' "No Fences" album in 1990, which was certified for eighteen-million copies shipped in the United States. Ten years later, it was released as a single and

went to number seven on the Billboard Hot Country Singles and Tracks and the sales together totaled twenty-three million.

David Wills charted twenty-one singles on the Billboard Country charts from 1974-88. "There's A Song On The Jukebox" and "From Barrooms To Bedrooms" made it to the top ten.

David Wills is also a talented songwriter that has penned songs for many country music legends in Nashville such as George Strait. Charley Pride, Martina McBride, The Oak Ridge Boys, John Schneider, Keith Whitley, Moe Bandy and Garth Brooks. The song he composed for Brooks, "Wild Horses", would go on to sell over 23 million copies.


David Wills recorded several really good songs that made the charts between 1974 and 1988-twenty one in total. Going to number 19 on the charts, "Eyes of a Stranger" is a rock-flavored country tune that speaks of temptation and a spousal promise to resist such. The 1983 release "Lady in Waiting" is a heartfelt tribute to a soon-to-be-wife who sticks with her lover through thick and thin. "Paper Thin Walls" tells the tragic tale of overhearing one's lover making plans with another man, this all thanks to the slim walls of their home. "Miss Understanding" is an apology-and-thank-you letter to a gracious wife of a wild character and everyone's choice, "Marriage on the Rocks" relates the beverage to a faulty matrimony. All these songs are worthy of fans' attention.

The Pulaski, Tennessee native has spent the last forty years writing songs for Charley Pride Music Group and now he wants to share his great music with all of his fans.

He has gone back into the studio and cut two new albums full of songs that he wrote and he is back out on tour bringing his traditional country style back in a new way.
